



**Fort Hills Energy L.P. selects ISOTREATING  
Technology from Chevron Lummus Global  
for its Alberta Oil Sands Upgrader**

**Richmond, CA, June, 2006** – Fort Hills Energy Limited Partners (F.H.E.L.P.) headquartered in Calgary, Alberta signed a license agreement with Chevron Lummus Global LLC (CLG) for applying ISOTREATING technology to the new bitumen upgrader to be built in Alberta, Canada. The 150,000 BPCD bitumen upgrader includes naphtha and distillate hydrotreating plants utilizing ISOTREATING technology for the production of light sweet synthetic crude oil. With this award, CLG has been selected for five (5) Oil Sands Upgrading units with more than 700,000 barrels per day of licensed oil sands hydroprocessing capacity in Alberta.

CLG will provide an engineering package including a reactor design package, follow-up technical support during the detailed engineering design, ISOTREATING® catalysts, training prior to start-up, and start-up support during the commissioning of the upgrader.

CLG licenses refining hydroprocessing technologies and catalyst systems worldwide, and is a 50-50 joint venture between Chevron U.S.A. Inc., a wholly owned subsidiary of Chevron Corporation, and ABB Lummus Global.
