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### **RDS Technology from Chevron Lummus Global Selected for Nghi Son Refinery**

Chevron Lummus Global (CLG) has signed contracts with Nghi Son Refinery & Petrochemical Limited Liability Company (NSRP LLC), to provide process technology for a Resid Desulphurization (RDS) unit, with a total capacity of 105,000 barrels per stream day (BPSD), for the planned 200,000 barrels-per-day refinery in Nghi Son, Vietnam.

Nghi Son Refinery & Petrochemical Limited Liability Company is a joint venture company between Vietnam Oil and Gas Group (PetroVietnam), Idemitsu Kosan, Japan, Kuwait Petroleum International, Kuwait and Mitsui Chemicals, Japan. The refinery will process Kuwait Export Crude oil provided by KPC, and the RDS units will convert atmospheric residue into high-quality feed for an RFCC unit. The unit is expected to start up in 2013.

CLG's management said it was delighted by the selection and confidence by the four joint venture partners, all reputable international oil and petrochemicals companies, underlining the advantages of CLG's Resid Desulfurization technology, a result of a massive R&D program the past several years, and of huge importance to CLG's business.

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
