

Pertamina Selects Catalyst from Chevron Lummus Global

Richmond, CA, February 28, 2005 -- Chevron Lummus Global (CLG) participated in its first-ever e-auction of hydrocracking catalyst for Pertamina's Dumai Unit in Indonesia. It was also the first time Pertamina had conducted an e-auction for catalysts and was the culmination of a multi-year process. To begin the process, extensive pilot plant testing was performed on each vendor's catalyst to establish technical qualification. Once qualified, technical and commercial proposals were submitted and evaluated. CLG was successful in its bid to supply its premium mid-distillate selective ISOCRACKING® catalyst, ICR 142 to the Dumai hydrocracker. The catalyst has been shipped and will be loaded in July/August 2005.

CLG licenses refining hydroprocessing technologies and catalyst systems worldwide, and is a 50-50 joint venture between Chevron U.S.A. Inc., a wholly owned subsidiary of Chevron Corporation, and ABB Lummus Global.

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
